Board Certified Civil Trial Law Specialists and Civil Trial Law Specialist Certification Applicants have an obligation to disclose and report the following matters at any time during the certification period or certification application process:

- any conviction of a serious crime, regardless of whether the conviction was the result of a plea of guilty or *nolo contendere*, or of a verdict after a trial, and whether such conviction resulted in imprisonment, probation, fine, or suspension of sentence; and the pendency of any proceeding in which the applicant has been charged with serious crime. Serious crimes include any felony and any lesser offense, an element of which involved improper conduct or dishonesty;
- any proceeding that resulted in the applicant or specialist being disbarred, suspended, reprimanded, or otherwise subjected to professional discipline by any court, grievance committee, or disciplinary board, or in the applicant's or specialist's resignation from the bar of any court; and the pendency of any disciplinary proceeding against the applicant or specialist before any such disciplinary body;
- any malpractice claims during the past five (5) years that have resulted in entry of a final judgment or settlement paid.

All such matters must be reported to the MSBA Certified Legal Specialists Manager, within thirty (30) days after they are imposed or entered. Failure to do so may be grounds for denial of certification or recertification or decertification.
