Prof. Kenji Yoshino, Yale Law School, discusses his book *Covering: The Hidden Assault on Our Civil Rights*. In the book, Yoshino asserts that everyone covers; everyone downplays a disfavored trait so as to blend into the mainstream. He argues that the demand to cover can pose a hidden threat to our civil rights. Though we have come to some consensus against penalizing people for differences based on race, sex, sexual orientation, religion, and disability, we still routinely deny equal treatment to people who refuse to downplay differences along these lines.
