

POLICY STATEMENT REGARDING ROLE OF MSBA APPOINTED PERSON

Persons appointed by the Minnesota Supreme Court to a Supreme Court Rules Committee pursuant to the recommendation of the President of the Minnesota State Bar Association do not speak for or represent the MSBA. The appointee should listen to opinions expressed by members of the MSBA, but independently participate and vote on matters presented during tenure on the Supreme Court Committee, using his or her best judgment. The appointee's responsibility to the MSBA includes regularly attending meetings of the Supreme Court rules committee to which he or she has been appointed, and providing continuing updates to the MSBA Court Rules and Administration Committee regarding the Supreme Court Committee to which they were appointed.
