The U.S. Supreme Court will hear and decide a surprising total of four antitrust cases in the 2006-2007 term, covering predatory bidding (Weyerhaeuser), pleading (Twombly), implied immunity (Credit Suisse First Boston), and resale price maintenance (Leegin Creative Leather Products). Hear a panel of antitrust law professors from Minnesota's four law schools discuss these cases and other significant recent developments in antitrust law.
