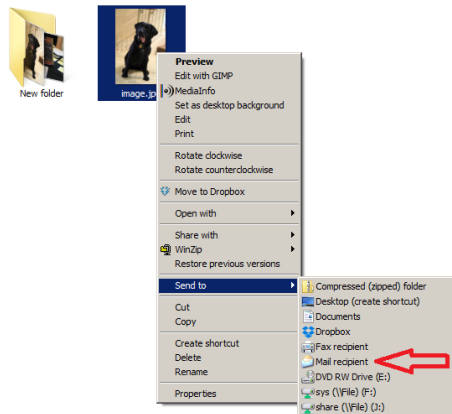


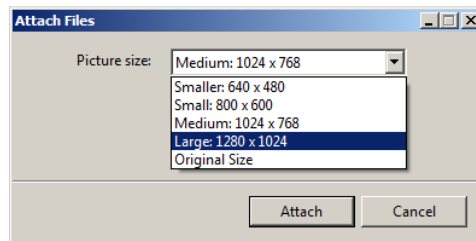
Quick & easy way to resize photo for MN Find a Lawyer profile

If you're one of the many members who recently got a new professional headshot at the MSBA's first headshot day last month, you may have noticed that the final image you received was high resolution, and too big to directly upload for use as your profile photo on [MN Find a Lawyer](#) (MSBA Directories have a size limit of 1 MB). Not to fear, there are many easy ways to resize the image.

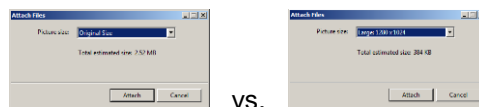
You can use your email program to reduce the size of images. Simply right-click on the image file from Windows Explorer and choose the "Send to" option. Then select "Mail recipient."



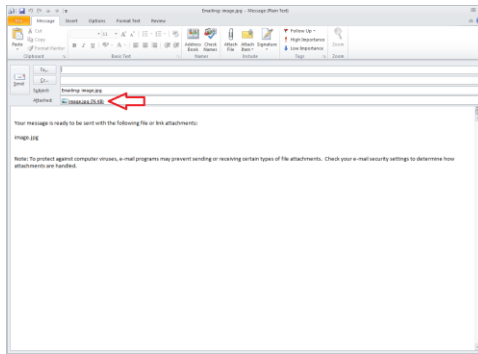
An "Attach Files" dialog box will pop up presenting different options for the size of the attached image.



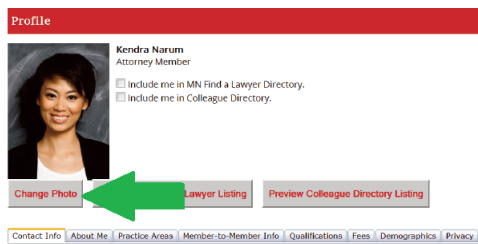
By selecting the different options, you can see how large your attachment (or resized image) will be.



Clicking the "Attach" button opens a new email message with the resized file attached.



If you want, you can email the image to yourself. Otherwise simply right-click and choose "Save As..." or drag-and-drop the file to your desktop (or anywhere else you want). Once you've saved the file somewhere, you can now upload it to MN Find a Lawyer (and/or the MSBA Colleague Directory) using the button on the [Edit Profile](#) page.
