<p>Public Attorney - A member employed exclusively by a government agency full or part-time.</p> <p>Legal Services - A member employed by a legal services program representing low-income clients for no charge or a reduced fee.</p> <p>Nonresident - A member admitted to the Minnesota bar who neither resides nor practices law in Minnesota.</p> <p>Under \$45,000 Income - A member with adjusted gross income from <u>all</u> sources, excluding the income of a spouse, of less than \$45,000 for the past year.</p> <p>Emeritus – A member 70 years or older, no longer in full-time practice.</p> <p>Retired – A member who has been granted <u>retired status</u> on his or her license by the Supreme Court.</p> <p>Disabled - A member who is totally disabled is exempt from state and district dues.</p> <p>Active Military - A member on active duty (other than for training) with the United States armed services, Peace Corps, or VISTA.</p>
