The MSBA Labor & Employment Law Section invites nominations for the Labor and Employment Pro Bono Award. The Section's Governing Council established this award as a way of recognizing Section members who have demonstrated substantial pro bono involvement in the preceding year, related to Labor and Employment Law. The Governing Council shall grant this award to an attorney for recognition of the time, knowledge, and devotion given utilizing legal skills in employment and labor law for the good of our community.

The Section's Governing Council receives nominations and selects the award recipient(s) based on the following criteria:

- Demonstrated substantial pro bono involvement in the preceding year, related to labor and employment law.
- Other activities which demonstrate an involvement or contribution to the pro bono services our section provides or strives to provide.
- Other pro bono services which are unrelated to labor and employment law but reflect on pro bono commitment.
- Member of the MSBA Labor & Employment Law Section.
- Demonstrated commitment to maintaining the highest standards of civility, morality, honesty and ethics in professional and personal activities.
- Demonstrated commitment to improving the practice of labor and/or employment law in Minnesota.

If selected, award recipient(s) will be honored at the Section's annual meeting and spring dinner, which takes place on Monday, June 10, 2019 at Aria in Minneapolis.

If you would like to nominate someone for the Labor and Employment Pro Bono Award, please submit your nomination on or before **April 30, 2019**. Please include with your request:

- 1) The nominee's name, employer, email address and telephone number.
- 2) The nominator's name, employer, email address and telephone number.
- 3) A short narrative explaining the nominee's qualifications, such as a listing of pro bono activities and the name of organization for which pro bono services provided (If an individual, no names need be provided).
- 4) The nominee's resume, if available.
